

# My social assistance benefit is being terminated

Your social assistance benefit may be terminated for a variety of reasons, such as if you receive another benefit, find work or start living together with someone.

The decision you receive will explain why your social assistance benefit is being terminated.

## Participation & individual income supplement

If you have a combined income of up to 110% of the social assistance level, you are still eligible for an individual income supplement.



## Special assistance

If you have extraordinary expenses and a low combined income, you are still eligible for special assistance.



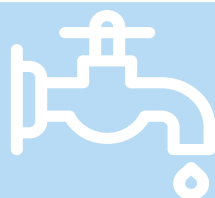
